OregonDoor is committed to sustainability. As part of this commitment, we offer an extended producer responsibility (EPR) product reuse strategy that encourages environmentally responsible practices for processing and disposing of wood and fiberglass reinforced polymer (FRP) doors and frames that have reached the end of their useful life.



This provides reuse, repurposing and/or recycling of door products that have reached the end of their initial life cycle and are not set for incorporation into a project's building reuse efforts. Wood and FRP doors and frames can be donated to Habitat for Humanity ReStore resale outlets. Proceeds from Habitat ReStores help Habitat for Humanity, a nonprofit housing organization, build strength, stability and self-reliance through shelter.
